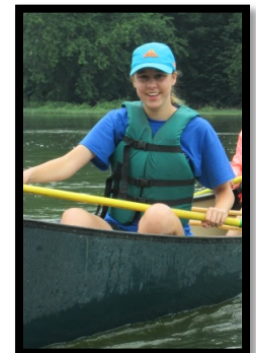
This two-week day camp offers a unique chance to:
